

3. Description

It is an official communication from the European Commission presenting the European Action Plan on the Cybersecurity of Hospitals and Healthcare Providers. The document outlines how the EU aims to strengthen resilience in the health sector through prevention, detection, and rapid response measures, supported by funding, training, and coordination across Member States.

3.1. Origin

This communication was published by the European Commission on 15 January 2025, as part of its EU action plan for healthcare cybersecurity.

3.2. Why is it relevant/important for ESCAPE

Healthcare systems are increasingly targeted by cyber threats, risking service disruption, data breaches, and patient safety. In 2023, 309 significant cyber incidents were reported in the EU health sector, with many involving ransomware.

The plan describes four strategic pillars (Prevent / Detect / Respond & Recover / Deter), along with governance mechanisms, new support centres, and funding mechanisms aimed specifically at hospitals and healthcare providers.
